- Using WordPress as a base, a modified version of advanced custom fields and a theme created from scratch, the archive now has over 1000 pieces of material - complete with metadata that uses Open Archive and JSON standards.
- Worked with volunteers and contract staff to design a system to scan, OCR, upload and input metadata that has resulted in material with over 90% correct OCR word count, plus a fully searchable database of metadata for material that is visual or audio.
- Developed Mailchimp templates and an email strategy that has grown the organization's base and resulted in thousands of dollars of donations.
